Hunt Named Director of Corporate Office

September 24, 2009, Alexandria, Va. – The Board of the National Credit Union Administration (NCUA) today named Scott Hunt Director of the Office of Corporate Credit Unions. Hunt had been Acting Special Assistant to the Acting Director of the corporate office since February, and prior to that Acting Director of the same office.

In announcing the appointment, NCUA Chairman Debbie Matz expressed confidence that Hunt will do an outstanding job in this position. “His talent, knowledge and dedication to the wide range of very complicated issues facing the corporates is well-known and has produced real results. Scott’s background and skill set make him uniquely qualified for this crucial position.”
