RE: Revised Standard Flood Hazard Determination Form

The Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) has recently revised (minor changes) the Standard Flood Hazard Determination Form, FEMA Form 81-93. The form is used for determining whether real property offered as collateral on a loan is located in a special flood hazard area. Notification of the revision was published in the *Federal Register* on January 20, 1999. The notice provided for a 90-day transition period from the date of publication. The date for required use of the revised form is April 20, 1999.
