To Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation:

We, the undersigned, do hereby apply for permission to organize and to operate a Federal credit union for the purposes indicated in and in accordance with the provisions of Public Act No. 467 of the 73d Congress entitled "An Act to establish a Federal Credit Union System, to establish a further market for securities of the United States and to make more available to people of small means credit for provident purposes through a national system of cooperative credit, thereby helping to stabilize the credit structure of the United States"; we agree to comply with the requirements of said Act, with the terms of this organization certificate and with all laws, rules and regulations now or hereafter applicable to Federal credit unions; and we hereby certify that:

(4) The par value of the shares of this credit union shall be \$5.00.

(5) The field of membership will be limited to those having the following common bond of association, occupation or residence: departmental civilian and military personnel of the Navy Department in Washington, D. C. and adjoining counties of Maryland and Virginia; field employees of the Navy Department in the same area stationed in Departmental Buildings; employees of this credit union; members of their immediate families; and organizations of such persons.

(6) The term of this credit union's existence shall be perpetual; provided, however, that upon the finding that this credit union is bankrupt or insolvent or has violated any provision of this organization certificate, of the bylaws, of the Federal Credit Union Act including any amendments thereto or thereof, or of any regulations issued thereunder, this organization certificate may be suspended or revoked under the provisions of Section 16(b) of the Federal Credit Union Act.

(7) This certificate is made to enable the undersigned to avail themselves of the advantages of said Act.

(8) The management of this credit union, the conduct of its affairs, and the powers, duties and privileges of its directors, officers, committees and mem-


