

Federal Employee Viewpoint Survey

The 2015 Employee Viewpoint Survey results are once again positive for NCUA. The agency had a survey response rate of 67 percent, significantly higher than that of the federal government overall.

Agency employees again demonstrated their commitment to producing high-quality work; 97 percent of the agency's survey respondents said they were willing to put in extra work to get a job completed. Ninety-one percent said they constantly look for ways to do their jobs better, and 90 percent said they feel their work is important.

NCUA also showed strong increases in survey categories reflecting the agency's efforts to maintain a good work/life balance.

NCUA regards its employees as its greatest asset, and making the agency an "employer of choice" is a priority for Board Chairman Debbie Matz. NCUA is committed to maintaining a work environment marked by effective communication, respect, trust and opportunity.
