NOTICE OF PROHIBITION

WHEREAS on or about March 10, 2016, Mark A. Jesse ("Jesse") was sentenced on one count of Theft-Business Setting Over \$10,000, Wis. Stat. § 943.20(1)(b), a charge to which he previously pleaded no contest, in the State of Wisconsin's 4th Judicial District, in connection with his employment at Menasha Employees Credit Union;

WHEREAS a violation of Wis. Stat. § 943.20(1)(b) is a criminal offense involving dishonesty and breach of trust;

NOW, THEREFORE, YOU ARE HEREBY NOTIFIED THAT:

- 1. Pursuant to 12 U.S. C. § 1785(d)(1)(A) and 12 U.S.C. § 1829(a)(1)(A), Jesse is prohibited from becoming an "institution affiliated party" of any insured depository institution, as defined in 12 U.S.C. § 1786(r); otherwise participating, directly or indirectly, in the conduct of the affairs of any insured depository institution; and owning or controlling, directly or indirectly, any insured depository institution;
- 2. Pursuant to 12 U.S. C. § 1785(d)(1)(B) and 12 U.S.C. § 1829(a)(1)(B), no insured depository institution may permit Jesse to engage in any conduct or continue in any relationship prohibited in paragraph 1 above;

- 3. Pursuant to 12 U.S.C. § 1785(d)(3) and 12 U.S.C. § 1829(b), whoever knowingly violates paragraph 1 or 2 above is subject to a fine of not more than \$1 million for each day such prohibition is violated, or imprisonment for not more than five (5) years, or both;
