



2. Pursuant to 12 U.S.C. § 1785(d)(1)(B) and 12 U.S.C. § 1829(a)(1)(B), no insured depository institution may permit Margucci to engage in any conduct or continue in any relationship prohibited in paragraph 1 above;

3. Pursuant to 12 U.S.C. § 1785(d)(3) and 12 U.S.C. § 1829(b), whoever knowingly violates paragraph 1 or 2 above is subject to a fine of not more than \$1 million for each day such prohibition is violated, or imprisonment for not more than five (5) years, or both;

4. The "Criminal Docket Court Case" document, Case No. CP-36-CR-0001221-2009, is made a part hereof and is incorporated herein by reference; and
