#### **NOTICE OF PROHIBITION**

WHEREAS on or about January 8, 2016, Mayty Lee ("Lee") was sentenced on two counts of Theft-by Swindle, Minn. Stat. § 609.52.2(4), charges to which she previously pleaded guilty, in the State of Minnesota's 2<sup>nd</sup> Judicial District, in connection with her employment at Affinity Plus Federal Credit Union;

WHEREAS violations of Minn. Stat. § 609.52.2(4) are criminal offenses involving dishonesty and breach of trust;

NOW, THEREFORE, YOU ARE HEREBY NOTIFIED THAT:

- 1. Pursuant to 12 U.S. C. § 1785(d)(1)(A) and 12 U.S.C. § 1829(a)(1)(A), Lee is prohibited from becoming an "institution affiliated party" of any insured depository institution, as defined in 12 U.S.C. § 1786(r); otherwise participating, directly or indirectly, in the conduct of the affairs of any insured depository institution; and owning or controlling, directly or indirectly, any insured depository institution;
- 2. Pursuant to 12 U.S. C. § 1785(d)(1)(B) and 12 U.S.C. § 1829(a)(1)(B), no insured depository institution may permit Lee to engage in any conduct or continue in any relationship prohibited in paragraph 1 above;

- 3. Pursuant to 12 U.S.C. § 1785(d)(3) and 12 U.S.C. § 1829(b), whoever knowingly violates paragraph 1 or 2 above is subject to a fine of not more than \$1 million for each day such prohibition is violated, or imprisonment for not more than five (5) years, or both;
- 4. The "Warrant of Commitment" document, District Court Case No. 62-CR-15-3612, is made a part hereof and is incorporated herein by reference; and
